All students are expected to read *The Book Thief*. In addition, they must read a second book: *I Am Third*, *Ender's Game*, or *Life as We Knew It*. Students will be held responsible for these works on the first day of class. For each novel, the student will complete an Analysis Chart (attached) to be turned in on the first day of school. There will be a test over these books on the first day of school with which students may use their charts, so make sure that they are complete. Teachers will check all written work for plagiarism.
