

2012 Holy Cross Alumni Softball Rules and Regs

- 1. Parking:** Parking will be relegated to: the Rivas street area alongside Gen. McMullen; the Medical Center parking lot across Gen. McMullen; and to the main student parking lot on San Felipe. No vehicle is to remain on the track area without a parking permit. Vehicles may enter to drop off b-b-q pits and the like, but must leave after things have been delivered.
- 2. Class Camp Area:** There is to be absolutely no camp set-up on the new practice field. All classes are reminded to clean up their areas and to be respectful of the established space of each class. Where there are questions about established space, we ask that compromises are met in the spirit of friendship and cooperation.
- 3. Outside Alcohol:** There is to be absolutely no outside alcoholic beverage brought onto our campus during the duration of the softball tournament.
- 4. Entry Fee:** Each member of a team is expected to pay \$50. Captains are asked to collect fees and turn them into the person in charge of concessions as soon as possible.
- 5. Curfew:** Curfew will be enforced beginning at 1:00am on Saturday and 12:00am on Sunday.
- 6. Tournament Rules:**
 - All games will be held at HC. Games on the bracket will be designated as HC #1 (baseball field), and HC #2 (softball field).
 - Bats will be furnished by the school; balls will be furnished by the school and will be sold for \$5.00 (price subject to change).
 - All brackets begin with a full count on the batter; one courtesy foul per at bat.
 - Courtesy runners are allowed in all brackets. Each player can have a designated runner with the understanding that the d.r. may run only for the position in the line-up that he/she is designated to run for.
 - In the event of a need for a player(s) to complete a team, a team can fill positions with players who are in the tournament (eliminated or not), an HC student, or a "friend" of HC. Any of these options are only possible with the approval of the opposing team.
 - Games have a 40 minute time limit with a 5 minute warm-up between games. No new inning will begin after the 40th minute.
 - Each competing team is responsible to keep score after each half inning. **Please make sure to double check each time.**
 - There will be no homerun limit on HC #1; however, a ball hit over the fence on HC #2 will be an automatic out. Every subsequent at bat for that player during that game will result in the player batting from the opposite side of the plate. There will be cars parked immediately outside the left field fence and the area immediately outside right field fence will be a heavily used walkway. We don't want cars getting smashed or people getting hit. **Any player deemed hitting the ball over the fence intentionally will be ejected from the tournament.**
 - No inappropriate colors or verbiage are allowed to be worn during the tournament.
