### **Per Student Cost of Education**

Instructional Cost	\$8,8 <b>01</b>
Total Cost	<mark>\$11,542</mark>


### **COST OF EDUCATION IN TEXAS**

- Approximately 250,000 students are enrolled in non-public schools in Texas
- Of these, 82,000 are in Catholic schools
- TO EDUCATE THESE STUDENTS IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS WOULD COST THE STATE OF TEXAS

\$2,125,000,000

(250,000 x \$8,500 per student)






