Dates and Times

Summer Enrichment Program will be June 5-July 3, 2013. Classes will meet daily Monday thru Friday. First class is from 8:00 a.m. to 9:50 a.m. Second class is from 10:10 a.m. to 12:00 noon. There will be no breakfast served. Snacks and drinks will be available for purchase. No more than two (2) excused absences are allowed.

Cost

The fee for each subject is \$150 or \$300 for two subjects. The fee includes cost of textbooks. The Summer Enrichment Program fees must be paid in full by 3:00 p.m. May 31, 2013. Payment must be by Cash, Cashier's Check, or Money Order. No Personal Checks. Refunds will not be allowed.

Dress

While dress is casual, it should be modest and reflect Christian values. Examples of inappropriate dress would include halter tops, tank tops, short skirts, t-shirts with any of the following: crude language or artwork, depictions of violence, alcohol or cigarette advertisement, and reference to drugs. Personal grooming should be consistent with rules and regulations of the regular school year.

Credit

Students that fail a Language Arts class or Math class during the school year must register for the **Summer Enrichment Program**. The **Enrichment Program** is not a substitute for the regular **Summer School Program**. Summer school credits will not be issued to students enrolled in the **Enrichment Program**.

Registration

Students must fill out the form on the opposite page along with school Counselor and Parent signatures and return or mail to Holy Cross of San Antonio.

Special Courses

Junior High English Skills

(For incoming 6th, 7th and 8th grade students)

This is an enrichment English class designed for the student who needs additional study in the basic skills of English. Students focus on spelling, grammar, and punctuation. The students also work on essential writing skills such as complete sentences, verbal usage, and paragraph structure.

Junior High Math Skills

(For incoming 6th, 7th and 8th grade students)

This is an enrichment Math class designed for students who need additional study in the four fundamental mathematical operations; multiplication, division, addition, and subtraction. They will also study simple fractions and decimals.

High School English Skills

(For All Incoming 9 th Grade Students)

Students focus on reading skills such as understanding the main idea, drawing conclusions, and making inferences. The students also review essential writing skills and learn organizational skills that will better prepare them for high school.

High School Math Skills

(For All Incoming 9th Grade Students)

This course prepares students for high school level Algebra I by highlighting traditional problem areas including fractions, decimals, percentages, and the metric system.
