- Write a one-page review of this book, as though you were reviewing it for a newspaper. Here are some questions to help you:
 - O Could you relate to any of Ellie's experiences? OR Could you relate his experiences to anything else you've read before? How? Why? You must be able to relate it to something!
 - O Did the author do a good job of describing a feeling of alienation? How? Why? Give a brief example (in your own words), from the book where he does this.
 - O Would you recommend this book to others? Why? Why not?
