





Holy Cross Alumni Softball Tournament

The purpose of the Holy Cross Alumni Tournament is to raise money for Holy Cross, have fun as family, and support the school. The goal is to raise \$50,000 this year.

THE RULES

- The Softball Committee has final say on all issues.
 - The Softball Committee is in direct communication with the appropriate school officials.
 - This event is run by the Holy Cross Alumni Association for Holy Cross alumni.
 - c. Any and all grievances (eligible players, uniform colors, etc...) need to be brought to the softball committee members and they will have the final decision on the problems. On the field calls by the umpires will be left to the umpires to decide.
 - d. We will be on a tight schedule this year so grievances between teams need to be brought to us before your game starts.
 - e. Softball tournament committee members are

Regarding TEAMS:

- Each team must donate at least \$1500 to the Holy Cross Alumni Association.
 - a. Exceptions to this are:
 - i. Graduating class: Donation is waived
 - Classes 2011, 2012, 2013: Minimum donation is \$500
 - iii. Girls teams: Minimum donation is \$250

All donations will be used to help Holy Cross with specific campus and education needs. If you have any questions on donations please join us at an up coming alumni meeting. All financials will be provided at those meetings

Team donations are due by May 15, 2014 5pm in Holy Cross business office.
 No exceptions. We need this commitment from teams so we have time to plan the brackets and prepare for the weekend.

- Each team must appoint a captain. The captain must provide his/her cell phone number & must accept text messages.
 - Official messages about the tournament will be sent via text before and during the tournament, as the first choice in communication methods.
 Phone calls will follow, if necessary.
 - b. It is the captains' responsibility to communicate to the rest of his/her team.
- 5. Teams should consist of 8 or more Holy Cross alumni. In the event that a team does not have at least 8 players, the team will forfeit the game <u>OR</u> the opposing team may approve additional players who are:
 - Holy Cross alumni who's team has been eliminated from the tournament
 - b. Current Holy Cross students
 - c. A "friend" of Holy Cross.

Please note that the decision to let a player play with your team will be left to the opposing team you are playing against before your game starts. We expect a gentleman's agreement between teams on these decisions. If an agreement can not be reached you can bring the issue up with a committee member who will make the call. Please remember that games have a 40 minute time limit with a 5 min warm up between games. We need to bring up grievances during the 5 min warm up or the game time will be shortened.

- Alumni classes may combine two or more classes in order to have enough
 players to play. They must register as a combined team at the coaches meeting.
- 7. If your class is fielding a team you will be expected to play with that team. No jumping of teams to create an all star team will be allowed. No giving an advantage to one team over another by picking up players. We are trying to keep play fair and competitive.
- 8. All players are playing at their own risk. All players playing will be required to sign a liability waiver to play. Neither Holy Cross of San Antonio nor the Holy Cross Alumni Association is liable for any injuries or accidents that occur. However, every effort will be made to assist any injured player.

Regarding GAMES

- All games will be at Holy Cross, unless otherwise posted by the softball committee.
- Bats and softballs will be furnished by the Alumni Association.
 - No unauthorized bats or balls will be allowed.
 - b. The cost of these is included in the entry donation.

11. The baseball field is HC#1.

There is no limit on Homeruns on HC#1.

12. The softball field is HC#2

- a. A ball hit over-the-fence on HC#2 is an AUTOMATIC OUT.
- b. Any player that hits a ball over-the-fence must bat from the opposite side of the plate on all subsequent at-bats during that game.
- Any player deemed to be hitting the ball over-the-fence intentionally may be ejected from the tournament.
- d. Over-the-fence on HC#2 is a safety risk, as people will be walking and cars are parked along the fence line,

13. All batters begin with a full count.

- a. One courtesy foul is allowed per at-bat
- b. The Softball Committee may decide to return to regular at-bat foul and strike counting. Any changes will be announced by the Softball Committee before the tournament begins,
- Courtesy runners are allowed in all brackets. Each player can have a designated runner. The D.R. may run only for the position in the line-up that he/she is designated to run for.
- 15. Games have a 40 minute time limit with a 5 minute warm up between games. No new inning will begin after the 40th minute.
 - a. If the number of teams in the tournament allows, the Softball Committee may choose to play 50 minute games. Any changes will be announced by the Softball Committee before the tournament begins.
- Each competing team is responsible to keep score after each half inning. Please make sure to double check and keep score.
- Respect umpires at all times. They will call the game according to ASA rules. They will have the final call on the field for any and all plays.
- 18. If no official notice of a weather cancellation is given, teams shall assume that the game is to be played as scheduled. Please see the Plan for Inclement Weather for further information.

Regarding UNIFORMS

Game uniforms must be Blue and Gold, or colors affiliated with Notre Dame. No inappropriate colors or verbiage are allowed on the field during the tournament.

Regarding CONDUCT in STANDS, FIELD, and CAMP AREAS

- 20. Foul or vulgar language will not be tolerated on the field or in the stands. It is the intent of Holy Cross to maintain a family atmosphere for all to enjoy. Loud obscene language is grounds for removal from tournament and the campus.
- 21. No fighting between teams will be tolerated. You must remember we are all Holy Cross family and we get together here to have fun and raise money for our beloved school. Competitive games are great but should they go beyond that and become a problem the game may be suspended and players or teams ejected from field, tournament, and campus. Further punishment will be decided on by committee members. Please do not let one or two hot heads ruin a great weekend for everyone.
- 22. Alcohol must be purchased from the Holy Cross Alumni Association at the concession stand. All laws must be followed and under-age drinking is not permitted. If outside beer is found person(s) will be asked to return the beer to their car. Violation of the outside beer rules and underage drinking rules will be grounds for removal from the tournament and the campus. As well as ban of participation in next years Alumni Tournament.
- Please keep camp areas clean. Also please respect each others areas. Remember that all our families will be attending this tournament and everyone should be respected.

Holy Cross Alumni Tournament Inclement weather plans

- In the event that bad weather is predicted for the weekend of the tournament then
 the day before the tournament the softball committee will have a meeting that will
 include the Holy Cross athletic director, grounds crew, and Brother Stanley. At
 this meeting we will decide whether to reschedule the games for two weeks after
 Memorial Day or proceed with the tournament as planned.
- If we do not have a contact number for the captain of your team we will not contact you. We will try posting scheduling changes on the Holy Cross web site if possible and the Alumni face book page if possible but these may not be available to us. SO AGAIN IF WE DO NOT HAVE YOUR CONTACT NUMBERS WE WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR MISSED OR CANCELED GAMES YOU MISSED.
- If the tournament is cancelled before it starts it will be rescheduled for two weeks after Memorial Weekend.
- 4. If the tournament has to be rescheduled after teams have started to play the softball committee will again meet together with Bro. Stanley, the athletic director, and grounds crew and make a final decision on if the tournament will be rescheduled or cancelled for the year.
- 5. Please remember that we come together for this tournament to raise money for Holy Cross and all efforts will be made not to damage the fields and track in bad weather. The softball committee's goals are to provide a fun, family environment for all who attend and if we have any doubt that we can have a safe game we reserve the right to reschedule or cancel the tournament as needed.

2013 Football Field Parking Entry/Exit Rules



This year because of liability and safety concerns, no motorized vehicles such as motor homes, motorcycles, u-haul trucks will be allowed to remain on the football field on Saturday and Sunday of the tournament. However, vehicles will be allowed to enter in order to unload equipment and supplies to include trailers/storage units. Every caution shall be taken to not drive directly on the football field but to utilize the track.

We encourage that unloading take place on Friday. Access on Saturday and Sunday will be in the morning with all vehicles cleared-off the field by 9:30 a.m. both days. Any exceptions will be cleared by the Committee. Any vehicles remaining on the field will be towed by the contracted firm and all costs will be borne by the individual. If exception is made then security will hold driver's license and record a cell number so that in the event the owner of the vehicle overstays then they can be contacted before the wrecker is called.

We remind all classes as they are unloading that it is illegal to bring in any outside beer. During this time of set-up we will be working with team captains and participants to fill out registration forms for the alumni association. We are working to ensure greater participation and involvement from alumni throughout the year.

We are asking all classes to pick-up their pits and equipment on Monday, Memorial Day. If that is not possible then register the individual that needs access - only one. Access will start on Sunday at 9:00 PM. This is for pick-up only, so pits and supplies should be ready to go. You can access the school parking lot starting at 9:00 p.m. as well.

The Committee truly appreciates the cooperation and patience exhibited by the classes during the transition but due to liability concerns, this is the right thing to do for the benefit of all participants.
