Helpful tips!

- Visit www.campusexplorer.com to explore different colleges!
- Keep in mind some colleges offer an "EARLY" application deadline and this will give you a better chance at being accepted as long as you submit everything by this deadline
- Some applications require an Application Fee and some will waive the fee if you submit your application early!
- SAT/ACT scores can only be sent through collegeboard.org. They are \$12 each to send, however, if you qualify for a Fee Waiver, you can send up to 4 for FREE.
- Transcripts must be sent after you submit an application and can be done by taking a "transcript form" from the basket in front of Ms. Q's computer and filling it out with the college's admissions addresses. Place the form back in the basket for it to be sent.
- Essay & Resumes have to be submitted by downloading them directly to the application online.
- Remember to ask at least 2 of your teachers or your counselor for a recommendation. A recommendation form & resume must be given to your recommenders to give a little more information. Recommendation forms are found on Ms. Weaver's door!
