Who was Xavier Lopez & What is the Xavier Lopez Scholarship Fund?

Xavier was a 1974 graduate of Holy Cross High School. He was an active athlete who participated in football, track and basketball as well as an active participant in student government. At the time of his death in 1980, at the age of 24, he was a pre-med student at St. Mary's University and the University of Texas Health Science Center. His family began the endowment of a scholarship for students of Holy Cross to honor his promising life.

The Xavier H. Lopez Scholarship Fund is a not-for-profit corporation whose sole purpose is the awarding of scholarships to Junior students returning to Holy Cross High School to complete their Senior year. The fund assists students whose families are in financial need and may otherwise be unable to afford the school tuition.

Criteria for applying:

1. The student must be a currently enrolled Junior at Holy Cross and entering his/her Senior year.
2. The student must be in need of financial assistance.
3. The student must have a minimum cumulative 2.50 grade point average, and must maintain at least a 2.50 grade point average in his/her Senior year.
4. The student must have a good discipline record as determined by the Scholarship Committee.
5. The student must be involved in at least one HCHS extracurricular activity throughout the year in which the scholarship is awarded, and throughout his/her Senior year.
